Emergency Services to Families and Adults Case Worker

Anne Arundel County Department of Social Services is looking for a full-time contractual case worker in the Annapolis Emergency Services to Adults and Families Unit (ESAF). The position will provide emergency services to adults and families in crisis. Emergency could be homelessness; eviction; lack of utilities; lack of adequate food/clothing; lack of life-saving/sustaining medications; and vulnerability to maltreatment, self-neglect, exploitation, and/or violence. Services is assessing the extent of emergencies and/or crisis; evaluating the need and type of assistance; assessing the client's support system and existing resources; providing information and referral to community resources; brokering resources; advocating for clients; and determining if clients need additional services,

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in an appropriate behavioral science, such as: child development, sociology, social work, psychology, counseling, nursing, criminology, juvenile justice, human growth and development, human services, mental health or human resources management that includes at least 30 credit hour in human services or human development.
