

Keeping Your Medical Assistance (Medicaid)

It is not too late to reapply for coverage!

Follow these instructions *if you are:*

- Under 65
- A parent or caretaker relative of a minor child
- A pregnant woman
- Disabled but not receiving Medicare yet
- Have a child enrolled in Medicaid
- A former foster care child

If your Medical Assistance coverage has ended, you can now apply by using any computer that has internet access.

Follow these instructions *if you are:*

- Older than 65 and are not a parent or caretaker relative of a minor child
- Blind
- Disabled and not Medicare eligible
- Living in a nursing facility
- A current foster care child
