



Homelessness In Maryland

Statewide Homeless Data Collected in 2016


365 Annualized Data
 Accumulative data by providers serving the homeless. Totals represent those served through outreach, in shelters, and transitional housing or placed in permanent housing between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016.

Point-in-Time (PIT) Data
 A "snapshot" count of those experiencing homelessness on one night during the last two weeks of January. HUD requires a shelter and unsheltered count on odd years only. Only those in shelters were counted in January 2016. Therefore, 2015 data is used where noted.


The Counted Homeless in Maryland, 2016
