If your children are eligible to receive Pandemic EBT benefits, we mailed a P-EBT card in their name to your home. If you have not received a card, there are several possible reasons, such as:

- The address we have on file is incorrect
- U.S. Postal service delays

Note that the local office will not be able to enroll you in P-EBT. DHS uses information provided by schools to automatically enroll eligible children.
