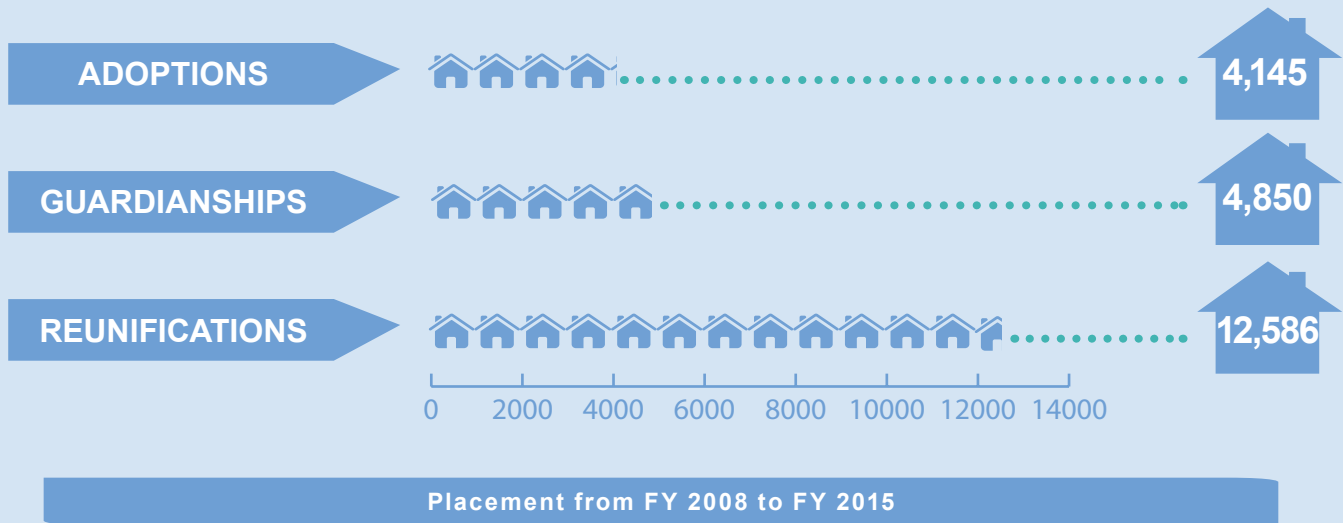

Place Matters

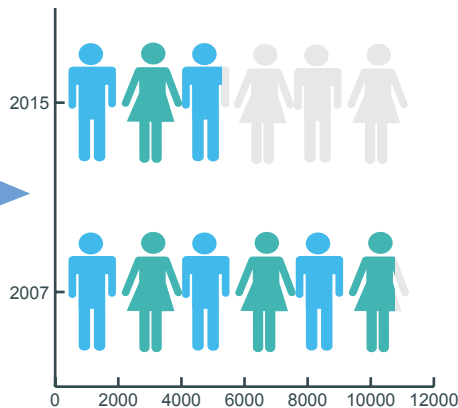


There are **fewer children in foster care than at any time in at least the last 28 years.***

Over **21,000** children have found permanent homes through **adoption, guardianship or reunification** with families since 2007.



We've reduced the number of children in foster care by **53%**, from 10,330 in July 2007 to 4,837 in June 2015.



41% decrease

Since 2008, the percentage of placements to group homes for children under 18 is down to 8%.¹



84% of youth under 18 in care are placed with families.
