#### **SUMMARY:**

Effective October 1, 2023, Maryland Human Services Article §5–501 requires that if a household includes an individual who is at least 62 years old and receives a federally funded Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefit in an amount less than \$40 per month, the State shall provide a supplement to increase the total benefit to \$40 per month. The state supplement will be the difference between \$40 and the household's current SNAP allotment.

The supplemental benefit automatically posts as <u>cash</u> to the customer's Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) account. Customers do not need to complete a new or separate application to receive the supplemental benefit.

#### **E&E PROCEDURES**

At the end of each month, E&E identifies households eligible for the Minimum State Supplement (MSS) and determines the total amount of State Supplement benefits each household is eligible to receive for the <u>next calendar month</u>. On the first business day of each month, eligible households will receive their State Supplement benefits in their EBT account.

The MSS benefit will be available as a cash benefit on the customer's EBT card. Customers will be provided information on how to access the cash.
