300.1 REQUIREMENTS

- A. Members of a TCA assistance unit must be technically and financially eligible for benefits
- B. Technical eligibility requirements are those that do not test income or assets
- C. Technical eligibility includes:

AGE	SUITABILITY OF THE HOME
CITIZENSHIP	STRIKERS
RESIDENCE	PRIMARY PREVENTION INITIATIVE
LIVING WITH A RELATIVE	CHILD SUPPORT COOPERATION
SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER	Disabled TCA/DEAP State funded program for families with disabilities

- D. Each of these requirements is discussed in these chapters
- E. When technical eligibility is not met, an individual or the entire family is ineligible.
- F. Technical eligibility is generally determined before financial eligibility because that determines:
 - 1. If anyone is technically eligible
 - 2. Who is in the assistance unit
 - 3. How to count income and assets

300.2 OTHER TECHNICAL FACTORS OF ELIGIBILITY
